2022 Track & Field Policies

Athletics Leinster wish to advise clubs of the following **Policies for the 2022 Indoor T&F Championships**. It is the intention of Athletics Leinster to **strictly** enforce these policies for the 2022 season.

Officials

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL CLUBS, WITH NO EXCEPTIONS, TO PROVIDE OFFICIALS FOR COMPETITION.

A minimum of one official per club must be made available and there will be no infield coaching allowed from this official. Failure of a club to provide officials will result in a club's athletes not being permitted to compete. All Clubs that enter athletes in a competition must provide officials on the day of competition. Officials must sign in at the check-in desk on the day of competition and be available to officiate for the duration of the competition. Officials will be provided with a High-Viz vest which must be on display at all times. Where nominated officials are not in attendance on the day of competition, alternate officials <u>must</u> be made available.

It is the intention of Athletics Leinster to wholly prohibit participation of offending clubs in competition.

ALL clubs will be expected to provide one official for every ten athletes entered in ALL competitions which they have athletes competing in.

Entries

- All Entries will be online at https://entry.athleticsireland.ie/#/
- An athlete cannot be entered on the system unless they have a current valid
 2022 AAI registration number.
- Any CLUB found not to be providing officials run the risk of having their numbers confiscated until at least one official is provided no exceptions will be made.
- Card payments only will be accepted.

STRICTLY NO INDIVIDUAL ON THE DAY ENTRIES OR EVENT AMENDMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED. There will be sufficient time for clubs to arrange and review entries in advance of each championship.

Relay amendments are acceptable, WITHIN REASON where entries were previously processed. Relay amendments must be written out and presented on the supplied sheet. Such amendments **MUST** be processed **EARLY** on the day of competition.

Please Note that there will be a charge of €5 per non-athlete/non-official entrance fee at the door of the arena for Days 1, 2, & 3.

Car Parking:

In the Athlone International Arena TUS Midlands there is no car parking fee unless you use the underground (€3 per Day), we (Athletics Leinster) do not receive any of this money.

In the NIA, Abbottstown parking is free, however, there is limited parking beside the arena, please follow direction for stewards on the day.

Athletic Proficiency

ATHLETIC PROFICIENCY FOR PARTICIPATION IS NOT OPTIONAL. In the interest of safety for all present, it is the responsibility of ALL coaches to ensure athletes exhibit proficiency in all events on the day of competition. In the event an athlete fails to exhibit the required or expected level of proficiency in a discipline, a coach or parent may be contacted, and the athlete sympathetically requested to desist from competition.

In-Field Coaching

COACHES AND PARENTS ARE STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED ON THE TRACK OR INFIELD AT ANY TIME.

The infield is for Officials & Competing Athletes. Parents & Coaches are not allowed on the infield, those found to be in violation of this guideline risk disqualification of their athletes and possible their club. Please stay outside of the perimeter fencing at all venues.

Warm up Area

In the Athlone International Arena TUS Midlands, this is an area upstairs overlooking the arena. This area is to be accessed by **athletes only** and they will be allowed entry to this area 60 minutes prior to their event.

In NIA, Abbottstown it is opposite the track. This area is to be accessed by **athletes only** and they will be allowed entry to this area 60 minutes prior to their event.

Photography

In line with the recommendation in Athletics Ireland's Code of Conduct, Athletics Leinster request that any person('s) wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close-range photography should register their details with David Denieffe, Indoor Secretary prior to commencing. It is not advisable that children are photographed or filmed without their permission and/or the permission of their parent/guardian.

Valid Competition

<u>Pertaining to Masters Competitions, AN EVENT WHICH HAS LESS THAN 3 COMPETITORS</u>

<u>WILL NOT BE HELD</u>. An event must have a minimum of three competitors to constitute a valid competition as there is no competition without competitors, in this event the **STEP-DOWN RULE WILL APPLY and will be strictly adhered too**.

THIS APPLIES TO ALL MASTERS CATEGORIES.

2022 Age Groups

- 1. Age categories calculated from 31st December in the year of competition.
- 2. No athlete may obtain a birthday in the year of competition and compete in that age.
- 3. Please note all ages in this booklet should be read as UNDER the stated age.

Under 12's - Born in 2011

Under 13's - Born in 2010

Under 14's - Born in 2009

Under 15's - Born in 2008

Under 16's - Born in 2007

Under 17's - Born in 2006

Under 18's - Born in 2005

Under 19's - Born in 2004

Junior - Born Between 2003 & 2006

Senior - Born Before 2007

Master OXX – Either XX or over on the day of competition

Entry & Competition Rules

- WA Rules will apply unless otherwise stated (rules can be found here)
- Athletes are allowed to compete in individual events as follows:

| Age Category | # Of Events |
|-------------------------|------------------|
| U12 - U19 | 3 Events + Relay |
| Junior, Senior & Master | 5 Events + Relay |

- All Athletes are **strictly** confined to their own age groups. A fine of €75 will be levied where this rule is broken.
 - o Only in the Indoor Relays an athlete may move up one age group.
 - At least 2 members of a competing relay team, participating in that event on that day must be of the correct age, exception U17, 18, 19 age groups where no limitation applies
- All entries must be made online and come through the club secretary for Juveniles.
- There is no limit on the number of athletes a club may enter per individual event.

Check-In:

- All athletes must collect a competition number, minimum one hour prior to their event.
- Track Athletes must check-in at where they collect their numbers. They then must report to the call room when their event is called and check-in with the call room official.
- Field Athlete can check-in at event when it is called. It will be called at least 15 minutes before starting. No call room is in operation for field events.
- Track and field Athlete's check-in when collecting their numbers, COLLECTING YOUR NUMBER DOES NOT MEAN YOU ARE CHECKED IN.
- Club singlet must be worn. If no singlet is available a PLAIN white tee-shirt is permitted. No other form of dress (e.g. football shirts) is allowed. National Apparel is not to be worn either at Athletics Leinster Championships or doing so risks disqualification.
- 5mm spikes **ONLY** will be allowed on track.
- False Start Rules apply.
- o U12 to U15; one false start allowed and a second leads to disqualification.
- o U16 upwards; a false start leads to disqualification.
- Athletes must leave the arena when their event is complete.
- There will be three attempts allowed in all field events, with a further three attempts for the top eight competitors (with the exception of the High Jump & the Pole Vault).

- U12 &U13 Athletes may use starting blocks but must do a crouch start, U14 athletes upwards MUST use starting blocks.
- Where a heat is listed, if insufficient competitors check in a FINAL will be held <u>at heat</u> time.
- Athlete must leave the track/field when their event has completed.
- Winning athlete must report for medal presentation 20 minutes after their event where possible or when called from the Public Address System.
- Athletes are not permitted to carry/use electronic or transmission equipment (i.e. Phones, iPods, Media Players etc.) in the competition area. Note: The competition area starts at the assembly/call room.
- Warm up marks for field events should be completed where possible before the time schedule, WARM UP MARKS SHOULD NOT INVOLVE PINS OR CHALK.
- Please have respect for the stadium and its environs.
- Please do not leave your personal belongings unattended. Athletics Leinster accepts no responsibility for items loss at its competitions.
- The first four (4) from each region qualify for the National Championships.
- o Except in the 600m & Relays where 3 qualify only.
- U12 Hurdles, U14 to U15 triple jump, and U16 400m are not a National Event and therefore there is no qualification.
- This will automatically be done by Athletics Leinster Indoor Secretary. Therefore, any athlete unable to attend please notify your coach who in turn is responsible for notifying the Indoor secretary via email on <u>Athleticsleinsterindoorsec@gmail.com</u>
- U17 U19 ATHLETES, ENTERED FOR ATHLETICS LEINSTER CHAMPIONSHIP BUT WHO DO NOT COMPETE IN THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS DUE TO INJURY OR OTHER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES MUST APPLY IN WRITING TO THE ATHLETICS LEINSTER INDOOR COMPETITION SECRETARY IF THEY WISH TO BE ENTERED FOR THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. There will be a notified deadline for application.
- A PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE ON THE WEEK OF COMPETITIONS ALONG WITH LIST OF REGISTERED ATHLETES FOR EACH EVENT. Athletics Leinster reserves the right to alter the timetables. Any alterations to the programme will be published on the Athletics Leinster website, www.athleticsleinster.org

3. Appeals

Athletics Leinster Appeals Procedure

Any appeal in the first instance shall be given orally by the athlete of club official to the competition track or field referee as appropriate within 15 minutes of the finish of the event. If the athlete or club official does not agree with their decision, they have the right to appeal to a Jury of Appeal accompanied by a fee of €20. (Refundable in the case of a successful appeal).

Appeal procedure

- This appeal must be presented using an official appeal form available upon request at 'Check-In', within 20 minutes of the outcome of the initial appeal to the relevant referee.
- The appeal will only be accepted when presented by a competent club official citing basis for appeal and any backup evidence.
- The Jury of Appeal shall, in the first instance, be composed of the Athletics Leinster Chairperson, the relevant Athletics Leinster Track & Field Secretary and the Track or Field Referee on the day.
- In the case of a conflict of interest on any particular matter an alternate shall replace the
- conflicted member(s) for the determination of that issue.
- In the event that any member/alternate of first instance is unavailable on the day of
- competition they may be substituted by the Athletics Leinster Vice-Chairman, the
 Athletics Leinster Treasurer or such other Athletics Leinster officers as are present on the day, as
 appropriate.

All appeals will be dealt with on the day. The ruling of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.
